## School Uniform Policy

It is the policy of Higham-on-the-Hill Church of England Primary School that all children wear the school's official uniform when attending school or when representing the school in an organised event outside normal school hours.

As well as being practical and smart, we believe that a sensible uniform policy will reinforce a positive learning environment as well as promote a unified school spirit and inspire a sense of pride in our school.

We respectfully ask all parents to support our school uniform policy and ensure that each child is sent to school dressed appropriately in smart attire for the day of learning ahead.

### **School Uniform items**

- Red Sweatshirt or Cardigan with the school logo
- White Shirt
- Black or Grey Trousers, Pinafore, skirt or shorts
- Plain Black school shoes

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child does not wear the following:

- Sports shirts (for example football or rugby tops)
- Hoodies
- Shoes with heels
- Trainers or "heelies"
- Jewellery (except for plain studs or jewellery with religious significance). Please note earrings must be removed for PE and swimming.
- Flip-flops, beach shoes or mules
- Smart watches. Any watch that connects to the internet, receives SMS, etc

### **P.E. Kit**

- White T-Shirt with school logo
- Black shorts
- Black pumps or trainers

Your child may also wear:

- Black tracksuit bottoms/leggings
- A plain black coloured hoodie/top

## **Footwear**

We want our children's feet to be healthy, therefore all pupils must wear sensible, well-fitting shoes with an appropriate low heel.

Boots are not allowed in the classroom, therefore on bad weather days if your child wears boots to school they must remember to bring their school shoes to change into.

Separate trainers can be brought in to wear outside on the field during playtimes.

## **Jewellery**

For health and safety reasons we do not allow children to wear jewellery to school.  
Exceptions may be made for:

- Wrist watches
- Small earring studs in pierced ears.
- Small objects of religious significance or medical necessity.

However, we do ask the children to remove these objects during PE and games to prevent any potential injuries from occurring.

## **Lost Property**

Please ensure that **all** items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name, as the school cannot accept responsibility for any articles lost or damaged on the school premises.

## **Recycling**

Good condition school uniform items that are no longer required can be donated back to the school, via the school office. Should you need any spare uniform please go to the school office and we will happily provide this from our second-hand stock.

## **Special circumstances**

As a Church of England school, we believe that ALL are welcome, therefore any requests for exceptions to the Uniform Policy on medical or religious grounds should be sent, in writing, to the Headteacher.
